UTAP Program

The Utah Telephone Assistance Program provides a \$12.75 discount (\$9.25 federal plus \$3.50 state) on telephone and broadband services for eligible Utah customers. You may be eligible for UTAP if you have home landline service through Manti Telephone Company and you qualify either by income or by program.

To qualify by income, your gross household income must be at or below 135% of the federal poverty level.

To qualify by program, someone in your household must be receiving help from one of these programs: Medicaid, SNAP, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, or Veteran and Survivors Pension benefits.

To Apply for lifeline assistance, go to www.checklifeline.org or pick up a paper application in our office and mail the completed application and required documentation to USAC, Lifeline Support Center, PO Box 7081, London, KY 40742.

Do Not Call Registry

You can control telephone calls from solicitors!

The National Do Not Call Registry, managed by the Federal Trade Commission (FTC), gives you an opportunity to limit the telemarketing calls you receive. After you place your residential telephone number on the Registry, most telemarketers are required to remove your number from their call lists and may not call you. However, you may still receive calls from political organizations, charities, telephone surveyors, or companies with which you have an existing business relationship.

You can register by calling toll-free, 1-888-382-1222 (TTY 1-866-290-4236), from the telephone number you wish to register. You may also go to www.donotcall.gov if you have an e-mail address. **Registration is free**.

Battery Back-up Notice

Copper-based phone service typically works during a power outage because the service provided its own power. Fiber-based services need backup power to keep operating. In the event of a power outage, your phone, internet, and television services will not work without a battery back-up on your line. Currently, there is a battery attached that offers up to eight hours of operation during a power outage (depending on the number of devices running).

There is **NO** 9-1-1 EMERGENCY SERVICE in the event of a power outage WITHOUT A BATTERY BACKUP. If you want up to twenty-four hours of operation during a power outage, you can purchase your own battery at local retailers or online.
